His journey did not follow a traditional Hollywood script. He has survived near-death encounters with psychopaths, defended a violin from armed attackers at 3:00 AM on Manhattan streets, and faced down a bulldozer barefoot at dawn to save the historic Actors Studio West from demolition.
